For the Salt Springers:

Stowel Lake Farm still has winter vegetables starts and will be selling them on their roadside stand tomorrow (Tuesday, the 26th) at 190 Reynolds Rd. If you want plants but can't get them on Tuesday, you can call to work something out: 653-4308

They have kales, collards, chard, mixed Asian greens and winter cauliflower (Purple Cape). It is getting too late to directly seed these crops, but these started plants should give you a crop this winter if can get them planted immediately. They also have cabbage seedlings, but it may be getting too late to get a satisfactory head to form.

There is still time to seed winter lettuce varieties and corn salad. As of yesterday, Foxglove still had a good supply of these seeds.
